

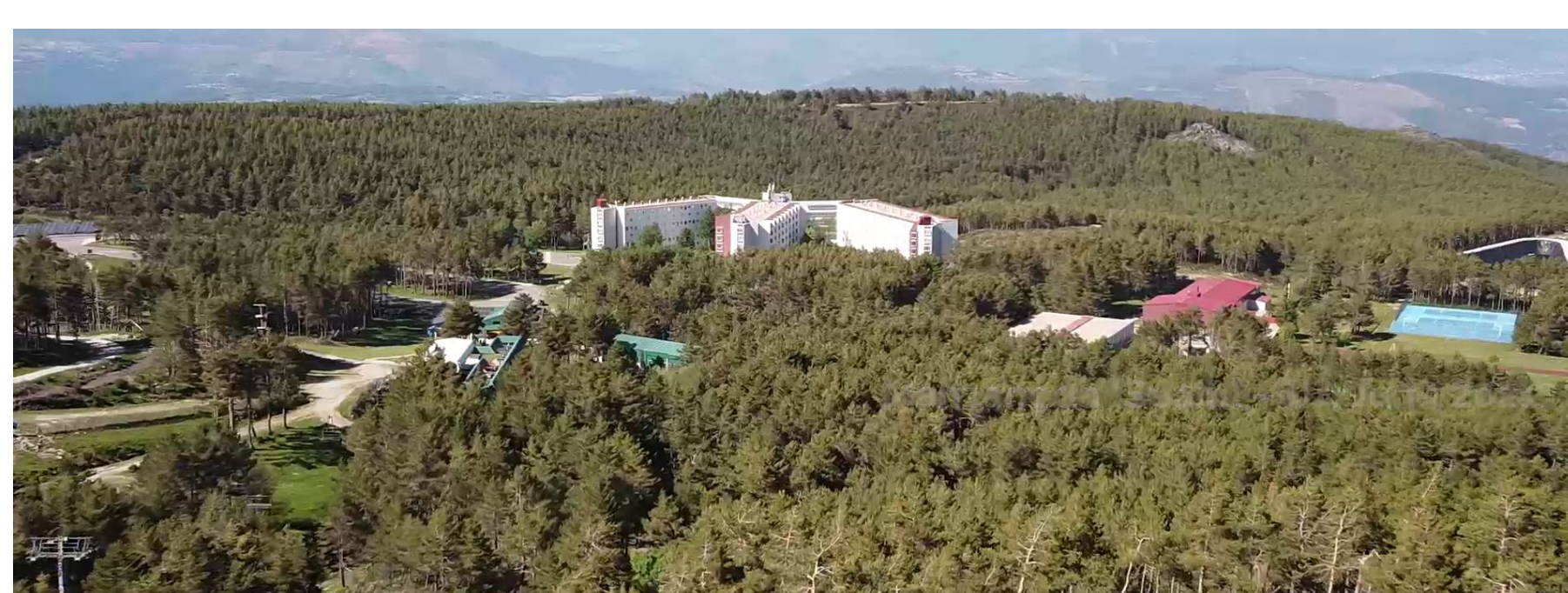
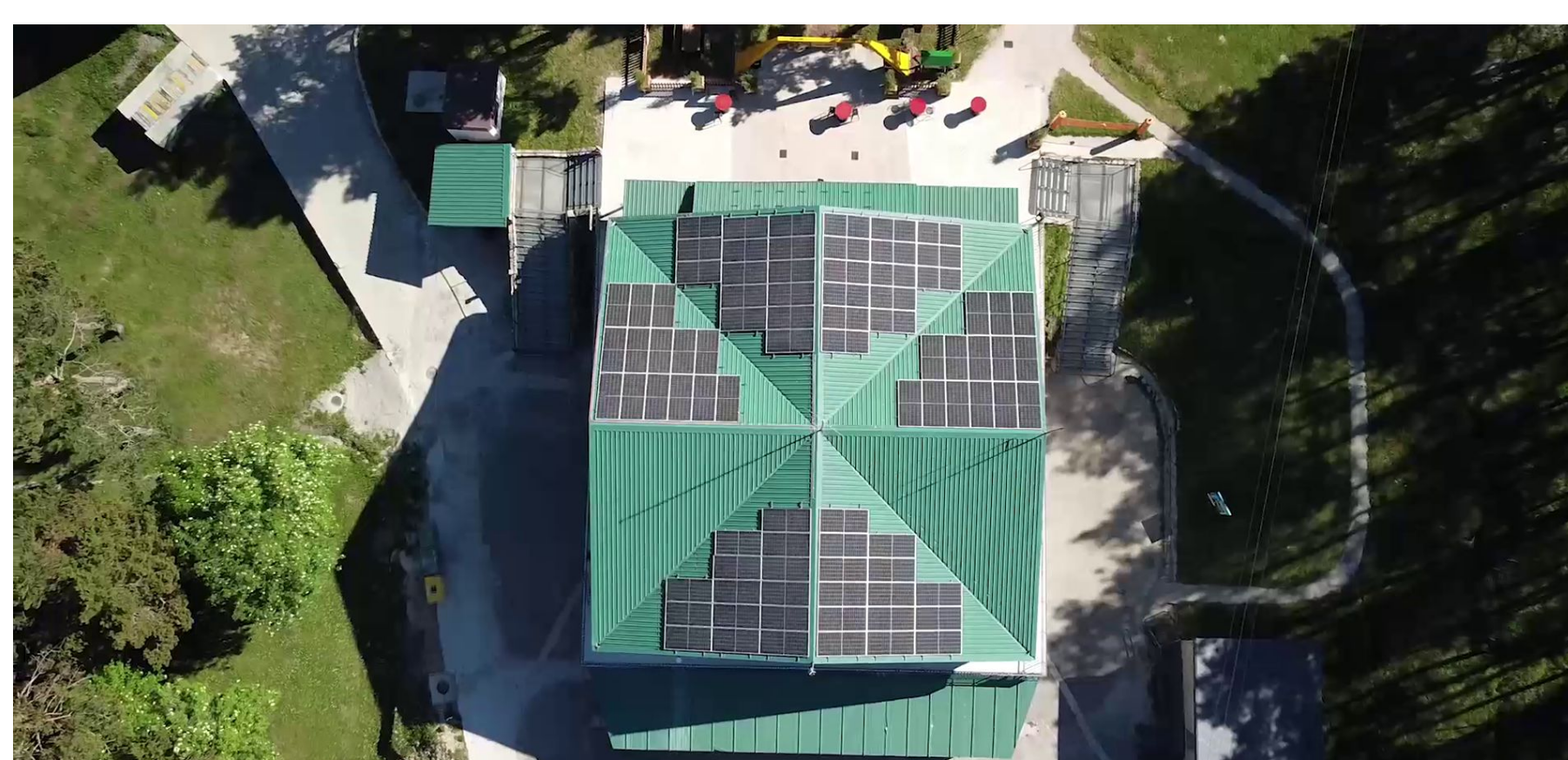
Manzaneda

Spain



Manzaneda is a municipality in the eastern province of Ourense, in the Galicia region of north-west Spain. The site is a remote rural village and ski resort consisting of 163 private households, 53 apartments owned by MEISA Hotel which are rented to tourists, the commercial premises and related facilities (ski lifts, commercial area, shops, restaurant, swimming pool, multi sports hall, water treatment plant, artificial snow guns). The resort hosts over 100.000 visitors per year and around 900 inhabitants are settled permanently. Depending on the season, many of the local citizens are employed by MEISA to run the activities and offer services to incoming tourists.
